We have been busy on the waterway lately, setting up *Quest*, *General Picton* and *Undine*. *Quest*'s mastallation has been redesigned so that we can drop it to go under navigation hazards, (low bridges) as we are going to go up to the quay in Haverfordwest for their June 4th celebrations. We have spent afternoons sailing up and down the Haven, polishing our technique in tacking and gibing, and now we shall bring her back into the dry dock to install her engine, just in case we cannot sail all the way up the river. We shall be taking *General Picton* and *Undine* as examples of the sort of boats which did ply their trade when the county town was a thriving port.
